

Public Announcement

For crimes according to §§ 1 and 2 of the decree for the fight against attacks against the German reconstruction work in the Generalgouvernement ... were sentenced to death by the court martial of the commander of the security police and the SD for the district Galicia:

...

40. **JOSEFEK, MARIA**, née **SLOWICZ**, from Lemberg, for sheltering Jews,

41. **JOSEFEK, BRONISLAW**, from Lemberg, for sheltering Jews,

...

The judgment has already been executed on those mentioned in numbers 1-30.

The condemned to numbers 31-55 are being considered for pardon.

If, however, in the next 3 months in the area of the city of Lemberg or in the districts of Lemberg-county and Zloczow, acts of violence, in particular attacks on Germans, members of the states allied with the Great German Reich or non-Germans working in the Generalgouvernement in the interest of the reconstruction work are committed, then - unless the perpetrator is seized immediately - the sentence will also be carried out on the convicted person envisaged for a pardon, and this in such a way that for every act of violence against one of the persons under the protection of the Great German Reich the intended pardon will lapse for at least 10 of the convicted persons ...

It is therefore in the hands of the non-German population,

by immediate arrest

or arrest of the offender(s)

or by acting on misleading elements known to them

or by reporting suspected persons

to ensure that the sentence is not enforced on the convicted person envisaged for pardon
